

A Quick Guide to The Earnings Tab

Your Pay. Your Way.

The **Earnings** tab is where you go to see the story of your hard work. No more waiting for a paper stub or trying to do the math yourself.

How much can I transfer right now?

When you open the Earnings tab, look for your earnings that are available to transfer. That's money you've already earned that you can access anytime you need it.

Can I see my upcoming paycheck?

Yes. Want to better understand your upcoming paycheck, including what you've earned, what you've transferred, and what has been set aside for estimated taxes and withholdings? Get the full breakdown by clicking on the paycheck, directly from the Earnings tab, and navigating to the activity view.

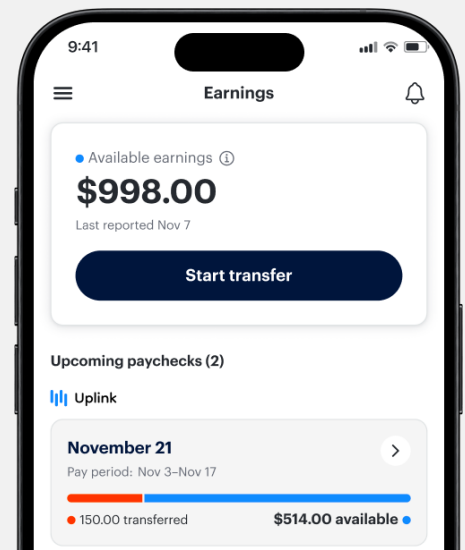
- **Gross Earnings:** Money you earned before taxes and withholdings as reported to DailyPay by your employer.
- **Estimated Tax & Withholdings:** An estimate of the amount of money taken out of your gross earnings.
- **Net Earnings:** Gross earnings minus estimated taxes and withholdings.
- **Transferred:** Every transfer you've taken during the period and any associated fees.

Did my shift or tips count?

Scroll down to see your Activity. It's organized by employer and pay period. You can see your shifts worked and tips earned reported by your employer. If you want to see only your Transfers or only your Earnings, use the toggle at the top to filter the list.

What about my old paychecks?

Need to look back? Click the 'See past paychecks' button to view all of your previous payday. One tap gives you access to information on your past daydays, including a detailed breakdown of what you earned, transferred early, and took home on payday.



Terms to Know

Planned Pay: Any pay you've set aside from payday using the Plan feature that pay period.

Sent to: Your take-home pay, which is your net earnings minus any transfers you've made and fees incurred. We've indicated the last four digits of the account the money has been sent to, which can be managed directly in Settings.
